National Oceanic & Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Seafood Import Monitoring Program (SIMP) Expands on December 31, 2018

Approved for 3 CCS credits

Do you import shrimps? Are you Ready and compliant?

The Seafood Import Monitoring Program is a US regulatory program that applies to certain seafood products that are imported into the United States. It requires particular data information and recordkeeping, and traceability information for those products that are declared at the time of making entry. January 1, 2018 is the mandatory compliance date for this rule.

***Shrimp and abalone compliance will be mandatory by December 31, 2018.**
